

How to setup IMAP account in Thunderbird 10:

Manual Configuration

If Thunderbird does not automatically detect your settings, follow these steps:

1. In Thunderbird, go to Tools and Account Settings.
2. Click **Account Actions** and then click **Add Mail Account**.
3. Complete the following fields: Your Name, Email Address (i.e. your email-id) and Password
4. Click **Continue**.
5. After Thunderbird fails to recognize your mail settings, click **Manual config**.
6. For the incoming server, select the desired method of retrieval and enter your mail hostname or server name as **mailg.cloud** into the server hostname field.
7. Leave authentication set to auto-detect.
8. For the Outgoing server, enter your server hostname: **mailg.cloud**
select the port :**465**
9. and select the appropriate SSL setting: **SSL/TLS**
based on your server configuration. Leave the authentication set to auto-detect.
10. For the username : [your email-id](#) enter your full email address.
11. Click **Re-Test**.
12. Once the test has finished, click **Create Account**.
